Kalahari is a medium quick maturity Hybrid Grain Sorghum.
Kalahari has an open head type and excellent hybrid vigour.
Average Days to Flower: Spring Planting 69-72 days
Summer Planting 62-69 days

Performance

Kalahari displays good lodging resistance and has an attractive red grain colour. Kalahari adapts well across most environments and systems. It is suitable for both dryland and irrigated production.
