## EARLY MATURITY HYBRID GRAIN SORGHUM

### KEY POSITIONING / BENEFITS

- Very good yield for early maturity
- Very good stalk quality
- Very good option for late planted double crop or disaster plantings
- Very good drought tolerance
- Recommend 15 inch rows or narrower

### POSITIONING / MANAGEMENT

SP 25C10 is an early hybrid with cream colored grain on a purple plant. This hybrid is very well adapted to the Northern Plains and late planted double crop systems in the Great Plains. SP 25C10 is well suited for late disaster replants following failed cotton acres as late as mid-July. Very good drought tolerance and intermediate stay-green along with very good stalk quality provide consistent, stable performance.
